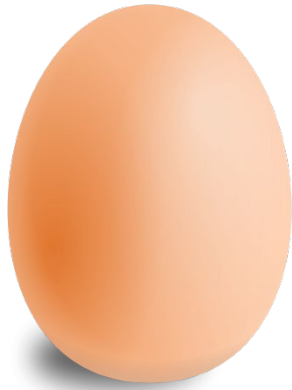


## 'Eggs-periment' Packing Exercise

### You will need:

- An egg
- A box big enough to fit your egg and some packing materials
- Acid free tissue (or something similar – ordinary tissue or newspaper will do)
- String to tie the box closed

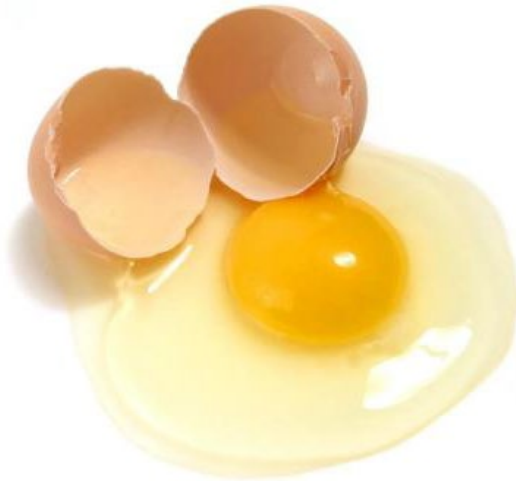


### Pack your egg...

1. Assemble your box
2. Use the acid free tissue to pack your egg safely in the box
3. The package should be able to withstand repeated opening, repackaging and poor handling

### Drop the package from...

1. Table top height
2. The height of a tall shelf
3. Down a flight of stairs



After each drop, open your package to check if the egg has broken then reseal before trying the next drop.

At which drop did your egg break? (if it did break...)

**Congratulations if your egg remained intact!**
